BLSC is located on a ten acre site on Lake Belwood, a reservoir managed by the Grand River Conservation Authority, about 4km east of Fergus. There is a club house with sail and gear storage, washrooms, a kitchen, picnic tables, camping area, and boat and car parking.

There is a ramp into the water and launching dollies that allow most people to hand launch their boats easily. There are two docks: one for launching and one for short term docking.

The club is managed by its members. There are ten directors elected from the membership who organize various functions throughout the year. Each week club members are responsible for keeping the general appearance of the club neat and tidy -- this normally takes about two or three hours and members are only required to do this once per year.

LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS

BLSC is on the south shore of Belwood Lake, 4 km east of Fergus off county road 18. From the 401 take Hwy 6 North (Exit 5 km West of 6 South Exit). At the North end of Guelph Hwy 6 ends temporarily. Turn East on Hwy 7 and then turn left onto Hwy 6 N again at the Canadian Tire. Follow 6 North into the South end of Fergus, then right on County Rd 18 (at the lights past the large plaza on the right). The tricky part is when you have to turn from county road 18 in towards the lake. Go down Ninth Street, when you come to the "T" intersection which is quite close to the water turn left. At the end of the road you will see the Belwood Sailing Club. If you would like to Map Quest, there are several back road short-cuts.
